

# **Apply to TUAS now!**

Again it is the time to apply for the exchange studies at Turku University of Applied Science (TUAS), Finland. # **Application**

The application deadlines for incoming exchange students are **15 April for the autumn term / first semester and 15 October for the spring term / second semester.** The online application form can be found at our webpage (<a href="www.tuas.fi/exchangestudents">www.tuas.fi/exchangestudents</a> - How to apply). Please see the detailed instructions for the application process at our webpage. The required application documents are **Learning Agreement**, **Transcript of Records**, **CV** and **motivation letter**. All the application documents should be uploaded to the Mobility Online system. **Nursing and social services students** should also fill in the **'Exchange student information sheet'**, which the international coordinator will send to all accepted applicants after the application deadline.

# Studying and courses

The autumn semester will start on week 35 with orientation days for all incoming exchange students. We hope that you will be able to arrive to Turku / Salo already for this orientation. If this is not possible, please let us know and we can try to organise the exchange to start later. Nursing studies at the faculty of Health Care at TUAS are held in two different locations in Kupittaa Campus, ICT-city (Turku) and in Salo IoT Campus (Salo, about 60km's from Turku).

- Courses. The course lists (international semesters) will be updated on the website before the application deadline. **Please note:** We strongly recommend that the students choose the different courses offered in the international semesters. We are able to offer <a href="maximum 6">maximum 6</a> weeks of clinical practice for nursing students. Practical placements for non-Finnish speaking students are extremely hard to find.

In addition we are organizing an International week each spring and autumn full of fascinating lectures by visiting lecturers from countries around the world. We are hoping that most of the exchange students would also take part in this event. You can also choose courses available for all exchange students: Finnish for Exchange Students and Get Finternational.

#### Accommodation in Turku:
