History and mission

History

Located in Porto, Portugal, ESEP is a non-integrated polytechnic higher education institution, dedicated to undergraduate and post-graduate education in nursing. Established in the 1st January 2007, the school is the merger of three public nursing schools of Porto, the ancient dating back to 15th June, 1896, a date that the school celebrates each year.

ESEP is engaged in innovative and distinctive education, supported on state-of-the-art technological equipment and fostering training informed by high quality nursing care standards.

The Nursing School of Porto (ESEP) pioneers nursing education in Portugal and is already a reference in matter of quality in education and research.

Mission

ESEP aims to deliver an exceptional education in nursing at undergraduate and post-graduate levels and to make significant contributions to society. It also provides specialized training programmes aimed at professionals in different areas of knowledge and skilled oriented.

Moreover, the school is actively engaged in research and in development programs, creating new disciplinary knowledge and fostering innovation in health.

The continuous establishment of national and international networks enables ESEP to promote globalization and the quality of nursing education and enhance students' curricula and experience.



2.1 **Undergraduate Degree** in Nursing 1st study cycle (CLE)

The course syllabus is structured by academic year and semester, corresponding to a total of 240 credits (ECTS) (6.000 hours workload).

The curricular units include theoretical classes and seminars with optional class attendance, theoretical and practical lessons, laboratory practice, tutorial guidance, clinical practice and compulsory practice attendance.

The total of contact hours specified for each curricular unit will determine the number of ECTS credits.

The newly graduate students who have met the requirements for Registered Nurses, are awarded by the Portuguese Nursing Council (Ordem dos Enfermeiros) with a professional licence enabling them to become nurse practitioners.

Students who have successfully been approved in the 'Curso de Licenciatura em Enfermagem' can apply to the 2nd study cycle (Master Degree).

Master degree programmes

Post-undergraduate & Post-graduate specialization courses

Master's degrees are aimed at delivering an exceptional education in nursing at graduate level and to make significant contributions to society. Students who have completed the undergraduate degree in Nursing can automatically apply for a Master's degree.

The school also provides specialized training programmes (post-undergraduate and post-graduate) aimed at professionals in different areas of knowledge and skilled oriented.

Master's Degree in Community Nursing

& Post-undergraduate Specialization Course

Community Nursing is targeted at the perception of health as a basic human resource with special focus on community, family and individual. Nursing community specialists are key professionals playing an active role in health care demands, transition in needs and actively participating in new policies and legislation targeted at populations, aiming to promote, maintain and restore health in the communities, families and in the individual.

Master's Degree in Medical-Surgical Nursing

& Post-undergraduate Specialization Course

Medical-surgical Nursing aims at developing and increasing empirical and scientific, ethical, aesthetic and personal knowledge. The purpose is to empower nurses with the necessary instruments to consolidate a specific culture focused on advanced professional help to those in critical condition, to the elderly and/or chronic, dependent and terminally ill patients.

Master's Degree in Rehabilitation Nursing

& Post-undergraduate Specialization Course

Rehabilitation Nursing aims at mastering training that prepares nurses for an evidence-based intervention on dependent patients, from the acute phase to the chronic condition, empowering the professional with all qualified skills to become a reference in care provision.

Master's Degree in Infant Child Health and Paediatric Nursing

& Post-undergraduate Specialization Course

Infant Child Health and Paediatric Nursing grounds its pedagogical approach on nurses training to achieve solid scientific, technical, ethical, cultural and research skills within the Child Health Nursing and Paediatrics domain.

Master's Degree in Maternal Health and Obstetric Nursing

& Post-undergraduate Specialization Course

Maternal Health and Obstetric Nursing provides the nursing professionals with the qualified skills and knowledge to focus on the development of the care process oriented to mother, child and family's health in specific given moments of the life cycle, and considering the gynaecological dimension.

Master's Degree in Mental Health and Psychiatric Nursing

& Post-undergraduate Specialization Course

Mental Health and Psychiatry Nursing, focused on health promotion and on the different levels of disease prevention, provides an important support to the health teams by contributing to a more empathetic and patient-centred care, carefully adapted to the patient, family and community.

Master's Degree in Clinical Supervision in Nursing

& Post-graduate Specialization Course

Supervision is a necessary tool for professional development and an important skill for nurses involved in teaching, in health care practice and in the management of clinical units and institutions. To become a full clinical supervisor, the nurse needs professional training in supervision and support.

Duration and total ECTS:

Master's Degree: 4 sem. • 120 ECTS Specialization Course: 2 sem. • 30 ECTS Course Coordinator: Manuela Teixeira (PhD)

Master's Degree in Nursing Services Management and Administration

Nursing Services Management and Administration empowers nurses to partake in health services management enabling the acquisition of conceptual instruments and critical analysis abilities, decisionmaking and assessment. It was designed aiming at training students to become chief nurses.

Duration: 3 sem. • 90 ECTS Course Coordinator: Manuela Martins (PhD)

Post-graduate Specialization Course in Services Management

Governmental policies determine specific professional requirements for management, including training in management and administration of health services. In line with these policies and considering the need to achieve a greater professionalization in management, this course is targeted at the development of management skills and competencies to become a chief nurse.

Post-graduate Specialization Course in Information Systems in Nursing

The use of information systems in healthcare services and in the development of an important connection between health services and populations has been determinant in building a reliable data network, fostering new opportunities in Nursing. The relevance of "Nursing Information" for governance in health is nowadays unquestionable and it derives not only from information systems legal and ethical enforcements, but also from those considered important to the decision-making processes, to the continuity and quality of care, to management and to the training and research in nursing.

Single Curricular Units

These training plans concern single curricular units included on the ongoing Courses at ESEP.

If successfully completed, the student will be given reusable ECTS credits.

Enrolment in these modules is limited and complies with submission order entries. Also, the enrolment in one of these modules does not imply enrolment in any course/degree. Upon successful completion of a module, a certificate will be issued, including grade and FCTS credits.

Should the student not apply for assessment or fails to complete the module, a registration certificate will be issued, upon the student's request.





Academic *Tuna* ► TAEP School Music Group

The *Tuna Académica de Enfermagem do Porto* (School Music Group) is a musical group created to encourage the passion for music. Through its many performances, the Tuna of ESEP has already reached a vast community of students and populations and helped to promote ESEP within local and national institutions.

Erasmus+

ERASMUS⁺ is the largest mobility programme in the world

Statistics show that in 2014 more than 270 000 students benefitted from this programme.

Mobility programmes are signed between higher education institutions and provide students the opportunity to attend a minimum of 3 months (or 1 academic term or trimester) to a maximum of 12 months. The traineeship mobility can last two months minimum, within one cycle of study.

Prospective incoming students can apply to ESEP until 31st May (application for the 1st semester) and 15th November (application for the 2nd semester), in the year prior to mobility.

After mobility a transcript of records is issued confirming that the agreed programme has been completed and acknowledging the results, using the ECTS credits.

All classes and clinical practice units are lectured in Portuguese, so a minimum proficiency in Portuguese language is required.

Before mobility, plans should be made to ensure your stay here in Porto. ESEP and other national institutions can provide incoming students all the necessary information.
